LOSING

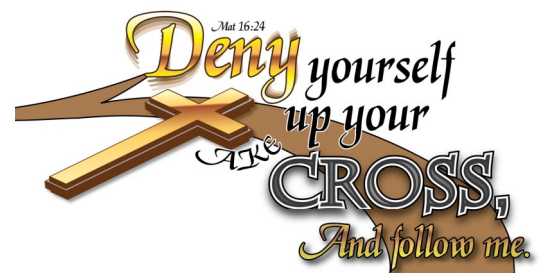

In the 1984 Olympics at Los Angeles, 16 year old Mary Retton became the first American girl to win gold medal in gymnastics. To accomplish this extraordinary feat, she had to make many sacrifices and made heaps of giving-ups during her years of training. While other teenagers were enjoying themselves with dating and merry-making and partying, Mary Retton could only participate in a very limited basis. She had to practise long hours in the gym and had to follow strict diet. But what Mary gave up in terms of good times and junk foods was little compared to what she gained in self-satisfaction and public acclaim when she won her Olympic gold medal. What she lost in social life of a teenager she found in the special setting of becoming a champion gymnast.

Mary Retton's Olympic experience illustrates Christ's paradox in today's Gospel reading: *"If a man wishes to come after me, he must deny his very self, take up his cross and follow me. Whoever saves his life will lose it. But whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."* This paradox: "Losing-finding" saying is recorded six times in the Gospels. Some people are afraid to start a regular program of exercise like jogging because they might lose out on some sleep or else be too tired to do their work. Yet once they get going in such a regime, they find that they sleep better and that their energy level rises to do their work.

This and similar other similar human experiences should convince us that often we have to lose something to gain something better or more valuable.. This no different in our relationship with God. Instead of hoarding so many clothes in our wardrobe because we are afraid we won't have enough or the best to wear, maybe we should let go of some of these clothes to help the poor. Instead of over indulging in food and drinks because we're afraid we won't get enough to satisfy ourselves, maybe we should give up some of those and save the money for the needy. Instead of indulging so much time with social media and communication gadgets, maybe we should try to lose some of those times on Facebook and spend more time with God through prayer and reflection. As Jesus said in today's Gospel that we sometimes have to deny ourselves to follow him as disciples.

The Lord will never ask us to let go of everything, but he will require that we often give up some of our time, energy, money, material things and love of a particular cause or to a particular person. And as we do so, Jesus will show us how to gain peace, joy, fulfilment and satisfaction. Whoever loses his or her life for Jesus' sake will find it.
