## THE MASS HAS COME TO YOU

“And behold,  
**I am with you**  
always,  
to the end  
of the age.”

Matthew 28:20



Let's suppose that we had the privilege of spending ten days as pilgrims in the Holy Land. We visit most of the historical sites made sacred and famous by Jesus: the manger in Bethlehem, his home in Nazareth, the tomb in Jerusalem, the scene of the Visitation, the location of the wedding at Cana, etc. At each place, we sit down to meditate while one of our group reads the bible passages relative to the scene. At the conclusion of our trip, we all agree that what the bible narrates had come alive for us and that henceforth we would read them with deeper meaning and appreciation.

In our imagination, let us walk through those same streets of Jerusalem to the place of the Last Supper, the holy cenacle or dining room. It is a large upper room located in the Mt. Zion section of the old city of Jerusalem, unfurnished now and open-sided. Rebuilt many times through the centuries, it still retains a basic similarity to the original room where Jesus offered the first Holy Mass with his apostles.

You may never travel to see where the first Holy Mass was offered but that, of course, is not necessary. The Holy Mass has come to you now. In your local parish church today, you can be present at the sacred meal. The essence of the liturgy is not *where* it happens but *what happens*. Jesus promised his presence in the bread and wine at the first Mass and each Mass that follows.

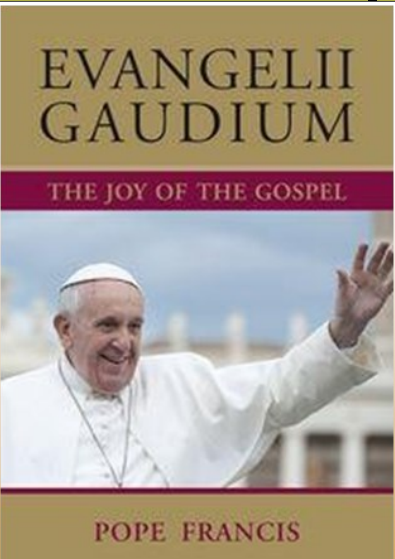

This presentation is for anyone in the parish who is interested in the words and actions of Pope Francis and what these mean for us today.

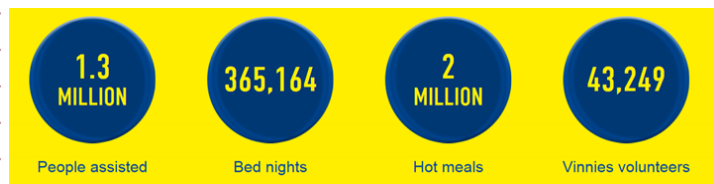




## SVDP DAISY HILL WINTER APPEAL

On the second weekend of June (13th - 14th) our parish is conducting a SVDP Daisy Hill Winter Appeal. We ask and plead that you be generous in supporting this appeal. You maybe interested in the following statistics.

### Where will your Donation go?



I realise that in recent weeks we have been called upon to contribute to places suffering natural disasters; this time we are asking to help the poor in our Daisy Hill community. There are far more families with little children living below the poverty line than we realize. Sorry to be the bearer of bad news but the number of these families is

increasing; people are being retrenched from work, others cannot find work. These are the stories we are hearing in each visit.

**How can you help:** Give a monetary donation, which is tax deductible. Put your donation in the envelope found on the seat in the church, put your name and address on it and put it on one of the collection plates. Your receipt can be collected from the piety stall at a later date. You can also donate non perishable foods items. At present we are in great need of food as our pantry is almost empty. Put items in the SVDP box at the entrance to the church. All donations will go directly to helping the poor as we have little overhead expenses.

Do not bring clothes to the church as we have no storage for them. Take them to the SVDP shop on the service road. We give vouchers for people to go there. If you have furniture or bedding contact us and we will arrange to have the items picked up. Let us give generously and not judge but rather reflect on St Philip Neri's words when he saw an alcoholic walking the streets of Rome. "There go I but for the grace of God".

### **Our parish will conduct the annual Propagation of the Faith appeal on June 20/21**

This weekend's Gospel highlights the life-giving nature of Jesus' sacrifice on the Cross. He breaks bread and pours the wine, as part of the first Eucharistic meal. It is what leads to life for all those who then partake. In a similar vein, this year's appeal theme highlights the life-giving nature of another tangible substance: water. Just as the bread and wine is mystically transformed, the water of Madagascar is changed, from dirty and disease-ridden, to clean and replenishing. But it can only happen with your help. And just as Communion now gives us spiritual nourishment, so too the work of Sr Rose offers both practical and pastoral support to the children and families of Madagascar. This is what missionaries do, around the world – they bring life, hope and love to people who would otherwise go without. Catholic Mission has always had a two-fold approach to its work – Good News, through sacraments and ministry, and Life, through a helping hand. When you are asked to respond to the appeal in a few weeks, know that you are making a difference, and changing lives, both through the pulpit and through the pump.
