33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time —Year C/2

For you the sun of righteousness will shine out with healing in its rays

As we approach the end of the Church's year, today's readings lead us to think about the passage of time and the end of the world. Though outwardly daunting, they provide a message of hope for those who stay faithful to God's love.

The prophet Malachi (**First Reading**) uses stark imagery to portray the fate of those who do not respect the Lord. But the ones who remain faithful to him will see the day that is coming as a time of joy and healing.

In the **Gospel**, Jesus predicts the destruction of the Temple in Jerusalem, but tells us not to fear wars, persecution, and natural disasters. While these things may seem like the end, in fact they are not: he cautions us not to be deceived by those claiming that 'the time has come'. Even when in difficulty, we are not to worry about what to say: the Spirit of Jesus will give us words and wisdom, as we bear witness to Christ. By staying secure in the love that God has for us, we will be held safe.

Paul presents himself as a model to the Thessalonian church (**Second Reading**), spreading the Good News and earning his keep. He stresses the importance of the whole community working for the good of all, rather than sitting around thinking about the future. The Psalmist is certain of the Lord's coming, when justice will prevail. All creation is invited to join in the joyful proclamation of that coming.

This week, I may like to pray for trust and inner strength, keeping Christ at my side, and responding to him in every moment of my daily life. We also continue to pray for the peace of the world.

GOSPEL Luke 21: 5-19 **REFLECTION**

I spend a few moments becoming still, asking for the help of the Holy Spirit to guide my prayer. Then I read this Gospel passage slowly and prayerfully.

I notice where my attention is drawn, and pause. How do I feel? Perhaps fearful; concerned for the suffering I see in the catastrophic events occurring around me this year ...? Or maybe I respond with hope, trusting in God's protection ...? I speak to the Lord from my heart, asking for whatever grace I need.

No matter how I feel, I trust that the Lord loves me just as I am. Perhaps I hear Jesus saying: 'Not a hair of your head will be lost. Your endurance will win you your life.' _ I can be confident of his loving and merciful care.

As I draw my prayer slowly to a close, I may like to pray with St Teresa of Avila, 'Let nothing disturb you, nothing frighten you ...' *'Let nothing disturb you, let nothing frighten you. All things are passing away: God never changes. Patience obtains all things. Whoever has God lacks nothing; God alone suffices.'* – Teresa of Avila

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord; and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.



What Is It? How Do I Go? What Do I Do? And More!

WHEN CAN I GO TO ADORATION?

This depends on your parish. Some parishes are blessed to have perpetual Adoration, which means that you are able to pray before the Lord at any time, day or night. In order to have perpetual adoration, at least one person must be present in Adoration at all times because Jesus may never be left alone. For this reason, few parishes are able to offer it.

If your parish does not have perpetual Adoration, there are usually specific times set aside for Adoration during the week. There is no need to sign-up or ask permission to attend, you can just show up and be with The Lord. You may also have the opportunity on retreats and at other special events hosted by your diocese.

Weekly Parables for Parishes. The Day of Fire

The end of another church year is near. We can tell because the readings are winding down to the end of the world. It's a cheerful note to end on, if you're a true believer. What could be better than the fulfilment of all of God's promises?

On the other hand, the end-times means the destruction of creation as we know it and a certain amount of real persecution and suffering. There's betrayal and hatred and the chance to plead your case in a court of lies – none of which we look forward to. On the third hand (if we're permitted a third hand), all of those conditions exist right now. We can pretend they're not there and turn a blind eye. But end-time suffering is happening in real time. Goodness and justice are always on trial.

Creation is ever endangered and suffering is no stranger. The old world is on the verge of slipping away. The new creation aches to be born. The end of the world is more familiar than we imagine, and the reign of God closer than we dream.

What part of you pledges allegiance to the old world?

What part aches to be reborn?

Give your testimony in favour of the new creation of God's love. Put your time, money, presence, and signature behind a campaign of justice. Let the new creation be born.
