#### **OUR JOURNEY BEGINS AT BAPTISM**

Today's feast marks both an ending and a beginning. It is the final celebration of the Christmas period, and yet it is also the first Sunday of 'Ordinary Time'.

It is appropriate that this transition from Christmas to Ordinary Time be marked by the feast of the Baptism of the Lord. That event, which we hear about in today's Gospel, was the beginning of Christ's active ministry in the world, and it culminates in the testimony of the Father to the identity of the Son. It is this identity that we celebrate during Christmas: the



miraculous truth that Jesus Christ is the true Son of God, the image of the invisible God, Word-made-flesh and Splendour of the Father. He is the beloved Son with whom the Father is well pleased. In other words, the person of Jesus Christ is constituted by the perfect love of the Father for the Son.

And our journey home too begins with baptism, when we are adopted as sons and daughters of God. This means that what the Father says to Christ in today's Gospel he also says to us: you are my beloved child. Today we hear from God the words that must transform our lives, because these words of love become the centre of our being now that we are a new creation in Christ.

Just like Jesus, our identity now *is* God's love for us; and this love is no longer that of a superior for an inferior as we might love our pets. Rather, it is the perfect, heart-breaking love of a parent for a child.

Therefore, as Christ's identity drives him into his mission of loving ministry in solidarity with us, so our new identity in solidarity with him must drive us into mission. Today the call is renewed for us to live lives of perfect service as Christ did, and we are strengthened for that service by the knowledge that, whatever joy and delight we have ever experienced in loving anyone, God's delight in us is infinitely greater.

In the meantime, we continue to pray for their safety.

We have finished the re-roofing of our Church and some roof repairs of our parish hall. We paid the full amount of \$ 87,230. A handful of our parishioners generously contributed and to date the total amount received is \$370.00. I wish to express my sincere THANK YOU for their thoughtfulness in supporting the maintenance of our Church building. Hopefully we can still receive more donations along the way.

We have been receiving good feedback and comments from visiting guests from other parishes who come to our Church for the Sunday 8:30am Mass. They feel they are warmly welcomed not only by those parishioners who greet them with a smile at the main door of the Church but also at the parking area where they are ushered for their parking space by our "traffic controllers" Terry George and Joaquin Mendoza. And I am very grateful and thankful to Terry and Joaquin and those who have been helping them every Sunday morning all throughout the year, rain or shine. May God's blessings be upon you and your family!

New members of our Parish Pastoral Council are ready to serve the community for the term of 2 years. There are 7 of them and I will officially present them to the congregation as they take their oath of service ceremony during the Sunday 8:30am Mass on 20 January. As our parish community is heavily multicultural, Pastoral Council members are also a mixture of different cultural background: Australia, Samoa, Sweden and Sri Lanka. Canon Law 536, paragraph 1 highly recommends that every parish should have a Pastoral Council whose members serve as consultors of the Parish Priest, with consultative vote, for all parish activities.

It is good to establish a good bonding or rapport with the school and the parish as we start working together for this year as a team. And so on 11 February, Monday, is our scheduled get-together-dinner with our 4 school administrators, 5 from the Finance Council and 7 from the Pastoral Council with our parish office staff Cheryl and Muriel. It will be held at the hospitality area of our Church.

We have distributed to the congregation our 2019 General Parish Calendar of Activities before Christmas last year and one might have noticed that there is no scheduled retreat for men and women. I have decided to have a "pause" for this spiritual activity for this year, and hopefully we can have it again by 2020.

Monday 11 February at 10am our parish will be host for the Logan Deanery Clergy meeting. We will be welcoming 7 parish priests.

Our parish Mass for Australia Day on 26 January, Saturday will be at 7:30am. It will be a thanksgiving Mass to God for giving us this beautiful land and its beautiful people.
