The Lord is compassion and love

The readings this week speak of forgiveness, urging us to forgive others just as God forgives us. God loves us unconditionally. There is no limit to that forgiveness, so long as we ourselves show forgiveness to others, and don't hold on to any grievances.

The **First Reading** directs us to remember and live by the commandments, and especially not to bear any grudge against our neighbours. We are urged to let go of any anger, hate or resentment.

The **Psalm** is full of praise and thanksgiving to the Lord. It tells of the strength of the Lord's love for us as well as his mercy; there is no end to his forgiveness nor love.

In the **Second Reading**, we hear of how the way in which we live our lives affects one other. Through Christ's life, death and resurrection, he has shown us that we belong to him both in life and death, unless we choose to turn away.

The parable of the unforgiving servant in the **Gospel** emphasises the message of forgiveness. So long as we forgive others with complete sincerity, God will show compassion towards us. So long as we repent, he will forgive our sins an infinite number of times.

Over the week ahead, let's pray for one another and welcome God's gift of forgiveness.

GOSPEL

Matthew 18: 21–35 REFLECTION

I begin my prayer slowly, then ponder how these words touch me. When I may have needed forgiveness, how did I feel? How did that change, knowing I had been forgiven? Relieved? Grateful? Reconciled? Renewed?

The message of the Gospel is that the Lord expects me to forgive freely too. How do I respond as I hear the answer to Peter's question, 'Lord, how often must I forgive?' Can I hear Jesus speaking to me, too, through this parable?

Perhaps there have been times when I have struggled to forgive ... to let go of anger, resentment, grievances ... or I have failed to show compassion? I share this with the Lord, and listen to what he has to say. I may find the response to today's psalm helpful,

'The Lord is compassion and love, slow to anger and rich in mercy.'

I thank God for the gift of forgiveness, and ask him to help me keep it close in my heart. Our Father ...

PARISH UPDATE

Bookings to attend Mass

Please follow the steps below to register your booking. If you do not have a computer please call the office during business hours on 3299 2000 to make your booking. Bookings on line close 6 hours prior to the Mass time.

If you are able to assist with the cleaning after Mass we would truly appreciate the assistance.

The steps for the registration is as follows:

The easiest process is to go to our webpage www.stedwardsdaisyhill.org.au and click on the icon provided.

- Click on 'Select a Date'
- Scroll down until you find the date you require
- Then click 'Ticket'
- The next screen you can choose the number of tickets you require (1 or 2 etc) if you are living in the same house and have the same surname you can do this on the one booking otherwise you have to do separate bookings for each one. There is a limit of 4 tickets per booking so if there is more than 4 required you need to do separate bookings.
- Click 'see more' to read all the conditions of the booking
- Then click 'Register'
- That will take you to the screen when you can enter your details. In the area 'First name' you can enter all (up to 4) first names (if you have ordered multiple tickets with the one booking) then tab to the surname area. This is for all attendees that have the same surname and living at the same address. ALL NAMES ARE TO BE REGISTERED
- All the information with a * is required by the guidelines which are to be hold on record for 56 days.
- Once you click 'Register' at the bottom of this page you will receive a confirmation of the booking to your email.



Reconciliation will still be by appointment ONLY.

Just a gentle reminder that part of the guidelines of our Church being able to open is that we have to abide by regulations. One of those regulations is that we ask that you do not congregate outside the Church or if you are, you must observe the social distancing rule.


