13th—14th May 2023 6th Sunday of Easter —Year A/1

The Father will give you another Advocate to be with you forever

Eastertide is nearly at an end. There is a sense that an important event is about to happen. As the readings this week seek to reassure us, we will not be left without comforting support.

In the **First Reading**, we see how active the Apostles are in spreading the Good News. They are welcomed even in Samaria and the people receive the Holy Spirit. The **Psalm** expresses the joy they must have felt. We can imagine the grateful disciples praying: 'Before you all the earth shall bow, shall sing to you, sing to your name!' But all was not plain sailing for these new communities. They often encountered persecution (**Second Reading**). Peter tries to encourage them, reminding them of the sufferings of the innocent Jesus. They are to answer their accusers with courtesy and respect.

In the **Gospel**, Jesus reassures his friends. He will not leave them without support, as 'orphans', but will ask his Father to send them help after he has left. The Spirit of truth will be with them.

In my prayer this week, I may want to reflect on Jesus' promises and draw strength from them, so that I can speak to others about my beliefs with greater confidence. I continue to ask Father, Son and Spirit to inspire all peoples to work for peace.

GOSPEL John 14: 15-21 REFLECTION

Whether I have plenty of time to pray, or can only manage to snatch a few quiet moments as I travel or do some mindless chore, I try to come to quiet. I take a deep breath and then read these verses from John's Gospel. 'If you love me . . . '. I imagine the Lord looking straight at me and telling me those words. Perhaps I recall Peter's anxious answer by the Sea of Tiberias 'Lord, you know I love you' . .

If you love Me you will keep My commandments

John 14:15

How do I respond now?

Jesus will soon be going to his Father, but he announces the coming of the Spirit of Truth. I ponder on 'goings' and 'comings' in my life. How did I feel about them? Has it been easy or difficult to adjust to a new situation? What did I do? Maybe just now I feel isolated and lonely, bruised by too many goings'. How does Jesus's promise of a new 'coming' help me? Jesus assures his disciples, assures me, that we will then understand the intimate relationship and the absolute love between Father and Son. Perhaps all I can do just now is to accept his word and patiently wait until all is revealed in total trust. Eventually, I bring my prayer to an end, thanking the Lord in my own words.

THE LORD'S DAY

When the COVID pandemic struck, I joined other bishops in deciding for a dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. Now that the pandemic seems to be receding, it is good for us to reflect not only upon the Sunday obligation but upon the meaning of Sunday itself. To call the first day of the week Sunday recalls the Roman name, but from the first Christians always called it the Lord's Day, in honour of the Risen Christ who is the true light of the world and the source of life. The Lord's Day was the weekly Easter and the weekly Pentecost, because on the first day Jesus Christ rose from the dead and breathed the Holy Spirit into the Church. It was the day that looked back to the first day of creation and forward to the last day of the Lord's return in glory. Even in times of persecution, Christians remained faithful unto death to the assembly of the Lord's Day. The spontaneous practice of the early days eventually became Church law. Yet it is not law that draws us to Mass but the Lord's desire to eat the Passover with us (cf Luke 22:15). The deepest reason we go to Mass on Sunday is not because we have decided or because the Church's requires it but because we are drawn there by his desire for us. In coming to Mass, we surrender to the Lord's love and let ourselves be drawn by him who wants to speak to our heart and share his feast with us. Therefore, in the Archdiocese of Brisbane from Pentecost Sunday of this year (28 May) the pandemic dispensation will be withdrawn and the Sunday obligation will be restored, so that all of us, responding to the Risen Lord's call, may say with one heart and voice, "This is the day which the Lord has made: let us rejoice and be glad" (Psalm 118:24).




