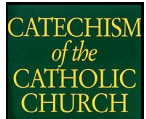
## **Peter's Pence Collection 06th—07th July 2019**

### **Basic questions answered according to the Catechism of the Catholic Church.**

#### **Q. Starting when to whom has the Church administered Baptism?**

From the day of Pentecost, the Church has administered Baptism to anyone who believes in Jesus Christ.

#### **Q. In what does the essential rite of Baptism consist?**

The essential rite of this sacrament consists in immersing the candidate in water or pouring water over his or her head while invoking the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

#### **Q. Who can receive Baptism?**

Every person not yet baptized is able to receive Baptism.

#### **Q. Why does the Church baptize infants?**

The church baptizes infants because they are born with original sin. They need to be freed from the power of the Evil One and brought into the realm of freedom which belongs to the children of God.


