**Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe Sunday
Year C/2**

Lord Jesus remember me

**Intellectually we know God loves us, but we pray for that knowledge to take root
in our hearts.**

What does being ‘King’ mean for Jesus? The **First Reading** describes the anointing of David as King of Israel. His people describe him as ‘one of us’, a person who has led and shepherded them.

The **Gospel** describes the reactions of people to the crucifixion of Jesus. We witness the humility of the thief who recognises his poverty and wrongdoing, and quietly asks Jesus to remember him. The **Psalms** is one of rejoicing and praise as the people of God come to the house of the Lord to celebrate their freedom.

St Paul speaks of the grace and joy that has come to us through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. In Christ, we gain our freedom through the forgiveness of our sin (**Second Reading**). Today I pray to know from the depths of my heart that I am a loved and forgiven sinner, welcomed by God into the light of his glory and joy. We continue to pray for the peace of the world, and for all who suffer.

GOSPEL Luke 23: 35–43 REFLECTION

I take time to come to stillness in the way that is best for me, conscious of moving into this holy space before the Lord. I ask the Holy Spirit to help me respond today with openness and generosity.

I read these words from St Luke slowly, taking time to savour them, to notice the words or phrases that draw my attention. Maybe it helps my prayer to place myself close to Jesus, watching as the scene unfolds. Perhaps I hear him talking to me, too. I sit quietly and listen.

I may like to stay with the differing reactions of the people before the cross of Jesus; the hostility, mockery, anger, rebuke or humble request. I notice how these words touch me. I ponder; how do they relate to my life today? What does humility mean for me?

I share my deepest thoughts and feelings with the Lord as I would with a trusted friend, asking for whatever help or grace I need. I spend a little time in silence before the mystery of the love of Christ crucified. In time, I slowly end my prayer, perhaps with the words ‘Glory be to the Father ...’, as I ask the Lord to deepen his life within me.

WHAT DO I DO DURING EUCHARISTIC ADORATION?

If you attend Adoration at your parish, it will most likely be in a small chapel or part of the Church. As a form of respect, you should always genuflect when you see the Lord in the Host. Maintain an attitude of respect, and if others are present, silence. On retreats or other special occasions, there may be music playing to help foster a spirit of prayer, worship, and Adoration. Always keep in mind that you are in the presence of God!

Kneeling, sitting, standing, and even laying on the floor before the Blessed Sacrament are all appropriate forms of prayer. Let your posture reflect your worship of the King and do what is comfortable for you.

You really don't have to "do" anything during Adoration. You can just sit there and look at Jesus. Take the time to be with Him. If you are the only person in the chapel, don't be afraid to pray or sing aloud.

This is your personal time with Christ.
