**Christ leads us into the Kingdom of his father**



Today's solemnity of Christ the King ends the Church's liturgical year on a high point. Perhaps, after the year we have had, we need, more than ever, to savour the full title of this feast: 'Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe'.

So that God 'may be all in all' (Second Reading), Christ is, indeed, king over the whole universe.

Though we may have felt – and perhaps still feel – 'scattered, during the mist and darkness' of 2020, God keeps the flock always in view (First Reading) and will show us where to rest. We are not abandoned. Rather, the care of the one, true, kingly shepherd means we really shall want for nothing (Psalm).

The call of this Shepherd King is heard in the Gospel, inviting us to a share, both in his service of others, especially to the very least, and in his very life. This week, let's try to be open to that call and respond with joyful and generous hearts.

**GOSPEL Matthew 25: 31–4(abridged) REFLECTION**

I begin by asking the Holy Spirit to help me reach the heart of this challenging gospel. I read it slowly and gently, remembering that the Son of Man (and King) is the one and same true shepherd. I can trust his call, guidance, and his judgments.

What is stirring within as I read? If I am feeling any fear or unease, I could ponder where this might be coming from. Or maybe, I am remembering times when I have received help, or been of help? I stay with these memories.

In today's First Reading, Jesus, the true shepherd, has kept me within his gaze. Here, Christ the King desires to invite me to the feast.

How can I respond to this invitation in the here and now? I ask to see, ever more keenly, Christ present to me in all circumstances. Perhaps I feel drawn to stay with Christ for a few moments, who appears to me both in glory and power ... but also, as one who is vulnerable and in need.

When ready, I end with the sign of the cross.

**PARISH UPDATE**

The steps for the registration to attend Mass is as follows:  
[www.stedwardsdaisyhill.org.au](http://www.stedwardsdaisyhill.org.au) and click on the icon provided.

- Click on 'Select a Date'
- Scroll down until you find the date you require
- Then click 'Ticket'
- The next screen you can choose the number of tickets you require (1 or 2 etc) if you are living in the same house and have the same surname you can do this on the one booking otherwise you have to do separate bookings for each one. There is a limit of 4 tickets per booking so if there is more than 4 required you need to do separate bookings.
- Click 'see more' to read all the conditions of the booking
- Then click 'Register'
- That will take you to the screen when you can enter your details. In the area 'First name' you can enter all (up to 4) first names (if you have ordered multiple tickets with the one booking) then tab to the surname area. This is for all attendees that have the same surname and living at the same address. ALL NAMES ARE TO BE REGISTERED
- All the information with a \* is required by the guidelines.
- Once you click 'Register' at the bottom of this page you will receive a confirmation of the booking to your email.

**Calling for Volunteers:**




St. Edwards Care and Concern group is seeking volunteers who are able to give a few hours a month for our Parish members requiring assistance in the following areas: **-Communion to the sick or elderly.** Volunteers who undertake this role for the sick or elderly, either in private homes or local Aged Care Facilities, are not required to already be a Eucharistic Minister. Provision of Communion is always undertaken with two Care and Concern volunteers present (in accordance with Diocesan Policy). The 'Communion to the sick' role occurs on a routine basis. At present however, due to COVID, Care and Concern is only delivering the weekly Church Newsletter to these people to comply with minimizing personal contact.  
**Additional areas covered of Care and Concern requiring Assistance: Hospitality – (Catering/Church functions and funerals; Meals) Home Visits Transportation.**


