Feast of The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph



GOSPEL

Luke 2: 22, 38–40

And when the day came for them to be purified as laid down by the Law of Moses, Mary and Joseph took Jesus up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord. When they had done everything the Law of the Lord required, they went back to Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth. Meanwhile the child grew to maturity, and he was filled with wisdom; and God's favour was with him.

REFLECTION

Even though Christmas was only two days ago, I may be able to get back to my 'usual' Sunday routine today – whatever that has become in recent times. So I settle down to pray. Perhaps I have a favourite object with me, a candle or some Christmas cards which are particularly dear to me.

When I feel relaxed and quiet, I read this short passage and let my imagination wander. I see Joseph, Mary and Jesus, law-abiding Jews, intent on fulfilling the Law of Moses.

I reflect on my own attitude to the law of the land, the law of the Church. Do I follow it dutifully or do I exercise my own judgment? What motivates me? The greater good, my personal needs or desires, a fear of being caught, or something else ...? How do I feel towards those who find they cannot obey the law?

Perhaps I am drawn to reflect on the young child Jesus as he grows up, sustained by the love of his parents and of God. Who are the people around me whom I can love and support, even in small ways, so they can feel it's 'Christmas every day'?

I ask the Lord to help me grow in wisdom, and thank him for be-



PARISH UPDATE

The steps for the registration to attend Mass is as follows:

www.stedwardsdaisyhill.org.au and click on the icon provided.

- Click on 'Select a Date'
- Scroll down until you find the date you require
- Then click 'Ticket'
- The next screen you can choose the number of tickets you require (1 or 2 etc) if you are living in the same house and have the same surname you can do this on the one booking otherwise you have to do separate bookings for each one. There is a limit of 4 tickets per booking so if there is more than 4 required you need to do separate bookings.
- Click 'see more' to read all the conditions of the booking
- Then click 'Register'
- That will take you to the screen when you can enter your details. In the area 'First name' you can enter all (up to 4) first names (if you have ordered multiple tickets with the one booking) then tab to the surname area. This is for all attendees that have the same surname and living at the same address.
- ALL NAMES ARE TO BE REGISTERED
- All the information with a * is required by the guidelines.
- Once you click 'Register' at the bottom of this page you will receive a confirmation of the booking to your email.
