

26th—27th February 2022 8th Sunday in Ordinary Time — Year C/2 The disciple will imitate their teacher

This Sunday's readings remind us that our words and actions reflect the reality of our inner selves. Even as we pray and long to live the values of Jesus, our speech may betray the ways in which we have yet to be fully converted, and show our need for God's mercy.

The First Reading encourages us to be discriminating in conversation with others, noticing the quality and content of another's speech before choosing to imitate them. The Gospel invites us to have Jesus for our teacher and guide: 'the fully trained disciple will always be like their teacher'. We are reminded to avoid the temptation to follow others blindly or to criticise them when our

own faults are much more evident. Our lives will reflect our own purity of heart and likeness to Jesus. While this may seem a hard teaching and difficult to put into practice, St Paul tells us that we should never give up, never admit defeat,



because, while we are working at the Lord's work, we can never be labouring fruitlessly. God will always give us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ! Reading)

And so we can recite the **Psalm** with joy, offering praise and thanks to the Lord, who sustains those who place their trust in God. Rooted in Jesus, we will flourish like a palm tree by an oasis or a sturdy Lebanon cedar. We will proclaim the goodness of God.

GOSPEL LUKE 6:39-45 REFLECTION

Coming to my prayer, I do not rush; taking time, I allow myself to become still in body and mind in the presence of God. I ask the Holy Spirit to help me to pray. I remember that, although I am a sinner, I am also uniquely loved and already forgiven by God, whatever my prayer might reveal to me.

When I am ready, I read these familiar words slowly, perhaps several times, noticing the phrases that seem to stand out for me. I ponder these words, sharing my thoughts and feelings with the Lord.

By whom do I allow myself to be led? Perhaps I see circumstances where I am like the one who cannot see and follows blindly. I ponder my relationships with others. Maybe I try to lead others, but need more discernment, or have a tendency to criticise. I ask the Lord to show me what I need to see about myself.

Where in my life do I need the guidance of Jesus, my teacher, so that I may reflect his goodness, more and more? I ask for all that I need. After a while, I end my prayer slowly, giving thanks.



INVITATION to THE SACRAMENT of RECONCILIATION (Penance) on 31 March 2022



We invite children in Grade 5 and above who have been baptized, and received the sacraments of Confirmation and First Holy Communion, to come forward for the sacrament of Reconciliation (Penance).

Children who have received their First Holy Communion were prepared with the 2nd rite of reconciliation – a simple celebration of God's mercy.

The First Rite of Reconciliation is the sacrament of forgiveness and celebrating God's love and mercy towards us. It is acknowledging those times when we know we have done wrong. This is an opportunity to make peace and restore relationships with those affected by our poor choices.

Reconciliation will assist the children to understand the process of examining their conscious on a daily basis – to seek forgiveness and to forgive others – to say sorry.




