You'll Get What You Need

A few years ago, the staff at the school where I worked gathered to pray for the recovery of a teacher with cancer. He recovered dramatically. About a year later, the staff gathered again to pray for another teacher fighting cancer. She died from the disease within the year.

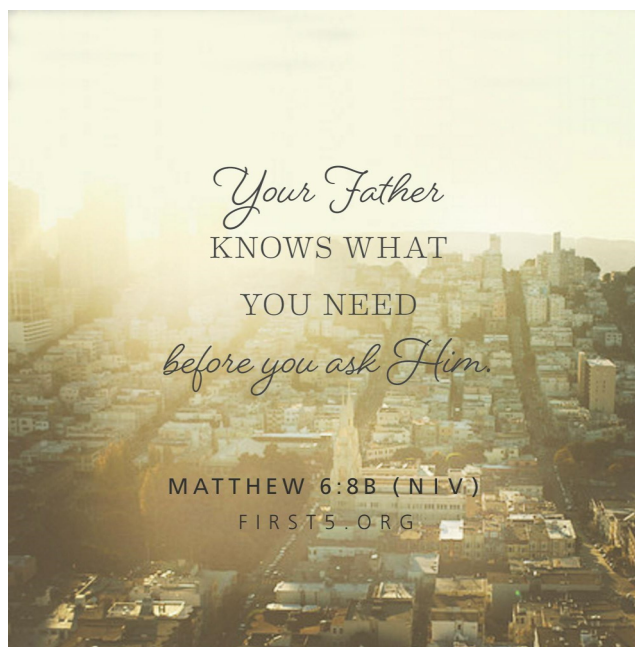
So why did God answer one prayer and not the other? Or, if God answered both prayers, why the different outcomes?

This week's Gospel will help us understand. Jesus says God doesn't always answer our prayers by giving us what we want. First, Jesus compares God to a person who gives his friend what he needs. Then he says God will answer our prayers by giving us the Holy Spirit.

What do you expect from prayer? Most of us pray for things we want, but God often gives us something we need – the courage and commitment to do God's will in tough times. You might want a good test result, but what you need are better study habits. So the answer to your prayer might be a teacher challenging you to work harder. You might pray for God to spare a loved one from an illness. God might answer by strengthening you with the Spirit so you can comfort your sick loved one. You might want a better life for the poor. And God might answer your prayer by calling your attention to an opportunity to serve those on the margins in your community.

Sure, our prayers might work miracles for others. But more often our prayers work miracles in us. Here's a challenge: keep track of your prayers in a journal, and also keep track of possible changes you see in yourself or your life. Talk with a friend about your search for answers to prayer. See if God makes changes in the world or in you.

Volunteers

One of the more well-known benefits of **volunteering** is the impact on the community. **Volunteering** allows you to connect to your community and **make** it a better place. Even helping out with the smallest tasks **can make** a real **difference**. We are looking for volunteers to cover various ministries within our parish.

Choirs: We are several choirs down and require musicians & singers for ALL our Masses.

Readers: There is a vacancy for a second reader on the fifth Sunday evening of the month. (this only happens 3 times a year so a good time slot to start learning).

Communion Ministers: There are several ministers who have stepped up and are now covering several rosters. Therefore we are looking for more ministers at ALL our Masses to take on this ministry.

Altar Servers: Sunday morning and Sunday evening Masses are in need of altar servers. If your child would like to be involved in this magnificent ministry please notify us.

Hospitality: Thank you to Iona & Ronet D'Mello for taking on a roster for Saturday evening once a month. This now gives us 2 teams therefore the teams are only on every 2nd month. We have 3 teams now for the Sunday morning roster however we could always welcome other teams to spread this roster out a bit. There is still only one team looking after the Sunday evening roster (once a month).

Care & Concern: This wonderful group distribute home communion to the sick. They also provide transport for elderly who would like to attend Mass but have difficulty in getting here. This group also provides hospitality after funeral ceremonies on request.

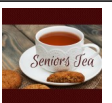

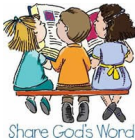
