27th—28th May 2023 Pentecost Sunday—Year A-1

Peace be with you!

O God, who by the mystery of today's great feast sanctify your whole Church in every people and nation, pour out, we pray, the gifts of the Holy Spirit across the face of the earth and, with the divine grace

that was at work when the Gospel was first proclaimed, fill now once more the hearts of believers.

'Peace be with you!' With these words the Risen Lord stood among his fear-filled followers (Gospel). He breathed the Holy Spirit upon them. With their hearts filled with joy, Jesus sent them out to bring the fire of his love to all.

With the Holy Spirit transforming their lives, the disciples began speaking in many different languages (**First Reading**). Christ was calling them to share the Gospel to the whole world. We too are baptised in this same Spirit.

Each of us has been given a unique gift, so that together as a community we become the risen Christ, bringing love and goodness to all people (**Second Reading**). Filled with the Holy Spirit we become a new creation in the Lord. The **Psalm** joyfully proclaims a time of rejuvenation as the spirit of the Lord moves over the earth.

On this Pentecost Sunday, let us ask for a spirit of renewal for the whole Christian community. We pray that we may overcome any fear, doubt or differences, and be united in giving expression to the joy of Resurrection, each of us doing so in our own unique way, while rooted in the same spirit of transforming love.

GOSPEL John 20: 19–23 REFLECTION

I prepare myself for this time of prayer in the way that suits me best today. Remembering that I am in the presence of the Lord, I begin my prayer using the words of the Gospel Acclamation:

'Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.'

After reading the Gospel slowly a few times, I use my imagination to enter into the scene of the first Pentecost. What do I notice about the room where the disciples are gathered? What would it have felt like to have been gathered there in fear and confusion? Have there been times when I have felt something similar?

Recalling such a time, I imagine the risen Lord standing alongside me, bringing his peace and breathing the Holy Spirit upon me. How do I feel now? What is Jesus sending me to do? I speak to the Lord as I would to a dear friend about my time of prayer. Imagining that I remain within the peaceful presence of Jesus, together we pray as one: *Our Father* . . .


Construction Update




