Who's Outside Your Door?

Have you ever noticed that this rich man never did anything wrong? He just went about his life. For whatever reason, he didn't even notice Lazarus. Maybe he was just busy. Who knows?

And that, Jesus says, is the problem. It's not what the rich man did. It's what he didn't do.

Life gets busy. I know some people that work hard all day and then spend the evening driving their kids to all sorts of sports and activities. I know young people that go to school all day and then spend the evening on homework, sports, part-time jobs, or school activities.

But Lazarus lives today. He is the lonely kid at school. He is the hungry child in Africa. He is the refugee in Syria seeking a place to call home. Jesus challenges us to care for him regularly. Make it part of your "busyness," not something you fit in when you find extra time.

Here are some tips. Ask God daily to show you the people others ignore. Read newspapers and surf the internet to learn about the problems that cause suffering in our world. Make community service trips and peace rallies part of your monthly schedule.

God has given you the power to change the world for people who suffer like Lazarus. Who's lying outside your door?

What's one thing you do to keep your focus on people like Lazarus?

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION UPDATE

On Saturday 14th September and Sunday 15th September Morning Masses we welcomed 58 children and their families to the *Rite of Enrolment* as part of their preparation journey to their First Holy Communion on 13th October 2019.



The children were invited to renew their baptismal promises and participated in the Liturgy. At the conclusion of Mass the children offered *Prayer Cards* (with their name on it) to parishioners asking them to pray for them. At the Sunday 15th September evening Mass Corrie Wall from the Sacramental Team had a basket full of prayers cards with all the children's names on and offered them to parishioners as they left Mass. This ensured our entire Parish family of St Edwards is on the journey with the 58 communion candidates.

Tuesday 10th September evening as we welcomed the rain the children and their families attended a session led by Fr Joseph and Carol Danby from Evangilisation Brisbane. They learnt of the *Story of the Invisible String* and our hearts always linked in love. They also enjoyed doing activities to demonstrate God's message. We will display their work in the Church on their communion Day. They learnt of God's Mercy and Love through the *Story of the Lost Sheep*. They came forward to Fr Joseph for the laying of the hands.

The children will continue their journey with their workbooks during the holidays until we come together on 10th October in preparation for their special day when they receive Jesus in Eucharist.

We appreciated the St Vincent de Paul members having a display of items for sale and they will offer this wonderful service again on 10th October. We concluded the evening with Shalom Peace song.


