



All Saints' Day

Think of the love that the Father has lavished upon us!

The Feast of All Saints celebrates the true life in Christ that we are all called to live.

The **First Reading** is a vision of the heavenly realm. It reminds us of the community of Saints who have gone before us, those inspirational people who embodied their love of Christ through their words and deeds.

The **Psalms** celebrates a vision of the world vibrant with the reality of God's presence in creation and his people. We are blessed when we are able to see the Lord throughout the whole of creation.

In the **Second Reading**, we are encouraged to think of the love that has been lavished on us by being called God's children. This is a truth that we need to pause and ponder on to let it truly transform how we see ourselves and each other.

Today's **Gospel** is the Beatitudes: a teaching that finds holiness both in the depths of human experience of loss, poverty and persecution, and in the expressions of compassion in response towards these sufferings. The lives of the Saints and of countless others have been transformed by their deep truth. These teachings speak to the difficult realities of our times too. Many live in poverty, or are innocent victims of war; many mourn lives cut short by the Covid-19 virus; others are persecuted for their beliefs. Let us hold all of these members of our human family in our prayer this coming week and pray for each other, that we may awaken to our true selves as lavishly loved children of God.

GOSPEL Matthew 5: 1-12 REFLECTION

After stilling myself and allowing the busyness of my mind to settle, I consciously place myself before the Lord. I ask for the grace to open my heart, body and mind to his presence. I lovingly read this familiar Gospel scene with a curious mind, hoping that I may be open to the possibility of hearing a truth for the first time. It may deepen my prayer to use my imagination to enter more fully into the Gospel scene. I see, hear and feel the crowds ... perhaps I am one of them? What do I notice when Jesus starts to speak and teach? How do people react to him ...? How do I react? What do I feel? Is there a Beatitude that speaks to my own lived experience? I imagine the crowd leaving, until only Jesus and myself remain sitting on the hillside. I share with Jesus my deepest desires ... I sit ... I listen ... When I am ready, I leave the hillside too, and close my prayer with my own words of gratitude.

PARISH UPDATE

The steps for the registration to attend Mass is as follows:

www.stedwardsdaisyhill.org.au and click on the icon provided.

- Click on 'Select a Date'
- Scroll down until you find the date you require
- Then click 'Ticket'
- The next screen you can choose the number of tickets you require (1 or 2 etc) if you are living in the same house and have the same surname you can do this on the one booking otherwise you have to do separate bookings for each one. There is a limit of 4 tickets per booking so if there is more than 4 required you need to do separate bookings.
- Click 'see more' to read all the conditions of the booking
- Then click 'Register'
- That will take you to the screen when you can enter your details. In the area 'First name' you can enter all (up to 4) first names (if you have ordered multiple tickets with the one booking) then tab to the surname area. This is for all attendees that have the same surname and living at the same address. ALL NAMES ARE TO BE REGISTERED
- All the information with a * is required by the guidelines.
- Once you click 'Register' at the bottom of this page you will receive a confirmation of the booking to your email.



THE FINAL PURIFICATION

November, once again it's a month to remember those whom God has called through death to eternal life. Once again it's time for Special Masses of all who have gone before us to God. November 2 is All Souls Day, the special day in the liturgical year set aside to pray for the dead. But why pray for the dead? This day presumes that some, who die are imperfectly purified of their sinfulness, and while assured of the eventual benefits of eternal life, are barred from immediate access to heaven until they are cleansed of their sinfulness, and are finally released to take their place at God's throne. Prayer for the dead is one of the greatest acts of charity we can perform to help our loved ones during their time in purification, so that they can enter more quickly into the fullness of heaven. (Vatican II, The Dogmatic Constitution of the Church, *Lumen Gentium*, No. 51). Our own prayers and sacrifices can be offered up to perfect our loved ones purification. On All Souls Day, we pray during the Mass in gratitude to God for these human lives, divine gifts to the world that they have been. Death is merely a step to pass through on the way to fulfilling God's plan. That's why we celebrate the life of the deceased person confident in the mercy of God and the promise of everlasting life. On November 2, on the day of the Commemoration of the Faithful Departed, the Church asks us to pray for the dead, with enthusiasm and great joy, that our loved ones might see God. The celebration of Mass, the sacrifice of Calvary continued on our altars, has ever been for the Church the principal means of fulfilling towards the dead the great commandment of charity.

To encourage this wonderful tradition of the Church, we write the names for those whom you would like a special Mass to be offered, in our November Mass Remembrance book then we place it on the altar during the weekend Masses. Also we write the names of all our departed members on the butterfly and stick it on the big cross as a symbolic way of our prayer for them. If you would like Masses especially offered during this month, please drop your Mass intention envelopes to the parish office or the collection bags. Please print names clearly so that we can transfer them to the book of remembrance.

"Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord; and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace." Amen.

CARE AND CONCERN GROUP

Calling for Volunteers:

St. Edwards Care and Concern group is seeking volunteers who are able to give a few hours a month for our Parish members requiring assistance in the following areas: **-Communion to the sick or elderly.** Volunteers who undertake this role for the sick or elderly, either in private homes or local Aged Care Facilities, are not required to already be a Eucharistic Minister. Provision of Communion is always undertaken with two Care and Concern volunteers present (in accordance with Diocesan Policy). The 'Communion to the sick' role occurs on a routine basis. At present however, due to COVID, Care and Concern is only delivering the weekly Church Newsletter to these people to comply with minimizing personal contact.

Additional areas covered of Care and Concern requiring Assistance: Hospitality – (Catering/Church functions and funerals; Meals) Home Visits Transportation.

We would be very grateful for any assistance you may be able to provide in these activities for Care and Concern.
